



CASE STUDY: FORMBY HALL

Formby Hall has been stylishly and comprehensively transformed from unused marshland into one of the leading and most picturesque resorts in the country and is now referred to as Formby Hall Golf Resort and Spa.

WHAT WE DID

We were able to save Formby Hall Golf Resort and Spa £33,000 on their electricity and gas contracts. Working with all suppliers we were able to present prices well below the levels they were already paying. All the electricity supply contracts now have a common end date saving time and costs for future contract negotiations for each meter.

We recovered costs for a long running dispute with their incumbent supplier after the supplier had charged them for a redundant building dating back several years.

New pumping equipment needed an urgent connection to help maintain the course in peak condition, we negotiated a new three phase connection to enable the new pumps to be connected in a timely manner to aid with drainage on the golf course.

With the water market deregulating in April 2017 we have collated all of the necessary information to put Formby Hall in the perfect position to take advantage of the competitive market.
